HOW DO I CLEAN MY SHOES WITH A BOA® SYSTEM?

Delicate cycle only.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• For leather items, avoid applying waxes, creams, conditioners, or polishes to the BOA® dial.• After the product has been absorbed into the leather, wipe the dial and laces thoroughly with a damp cloth.• Use caution when applying aerosols (such as sunscreen) while wearing BOA® shoes, as they can attract debris and accelerate component wear.
Do not bleach.

IF THERE IS DEBRIS IN MY DIALS, HOW CAN I CLEAN THEM?

- Grit and sand can be flushed from inside the system using clean running water while turning or opening and closing the dial.
- External debris can be removed with a damp cloth or soft-bristled brush and a recommended cleaning solution listed above.
- Allow all components to air dry completely before reassembling.

CAN I USE LUBRICANTS OR GREASE WITH MY DIALS?

BOA® does not recommend using lubricants, sprays, or degreasers on the system, as they may contain chemicals that can damage components.

These products can also mix with debris, causing buildup that may lead to failure over time.
